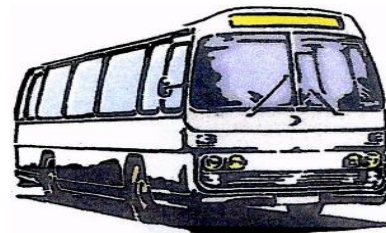
Tax Statements will be ready for pick up by January 23rd, 2015. Statements will not be mailed unless
