Tips for a safe and enjoyable summer!

Heat Safety

Have a plan – know how long you'll be outside and plan accordingly (clothing, sunscreen, and hydration).

1. Be extra cautious when the ultraviolet (UV) rays are the strongest between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.

2. Have access to air conditioning – it's the number one protective factor for heat-related illnesses!

Stay Hydrated

1. Drink plenty of water (even beyond the goal of having eight 8 oz. glasses per day)
2. Snack on water-rich foods like raw fruits and veggies
3. Know the signs of dehydration: extreme thirst, dry mouth, headache, muscle cramping, lightheadedness, and foggy thinking

Danger Zone

Know the warning signs and seek medical assistance if you or someone you know is experiencing these heat-related illnesses:

1. Heat cramps – painful muscle spasms
2. Heat exhaustion – weakness, heavy perspiration, cold/clammy skin
3. Heatstroke (or sunstroke) – hot dry skin, high body temperature, typically no perspiration

Sun Safety

1. Wear proper clothing – cover up to prevent burning (pants, long-sleeved shirt, hat, and sunglasses)
2. Avoid sunburn – apply sunscreen every couple of hours, even on cloudy days!
3. Seek shade – cool off and block the sun
