The Little Sisters of St. Francis of Assisi (LSOSF) was founded in 1923 by the late Mother Mary Kevin Kearney, a Franciscan Missionary from Ireland. The Little Sisters of St. Francis render their services in the East African Countries: Kenya, Uganda, and Tanzania. We are also working in the USA-Williamsburg in Virginia, Milwaukee in Wisconsin, Scranton in Pennsylvania, and Binghamton in New York. Currently, our institute has 750 professed members.

Our Mission as Little Sisters of St. Francis is to spread the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ, following the footsteps of our father St. Francis of Assisi and the spirit of our Mother Mary Kevin by loving, caring, and serving our neighbor in particular the poor, the marginalized and the needy in our world today.
